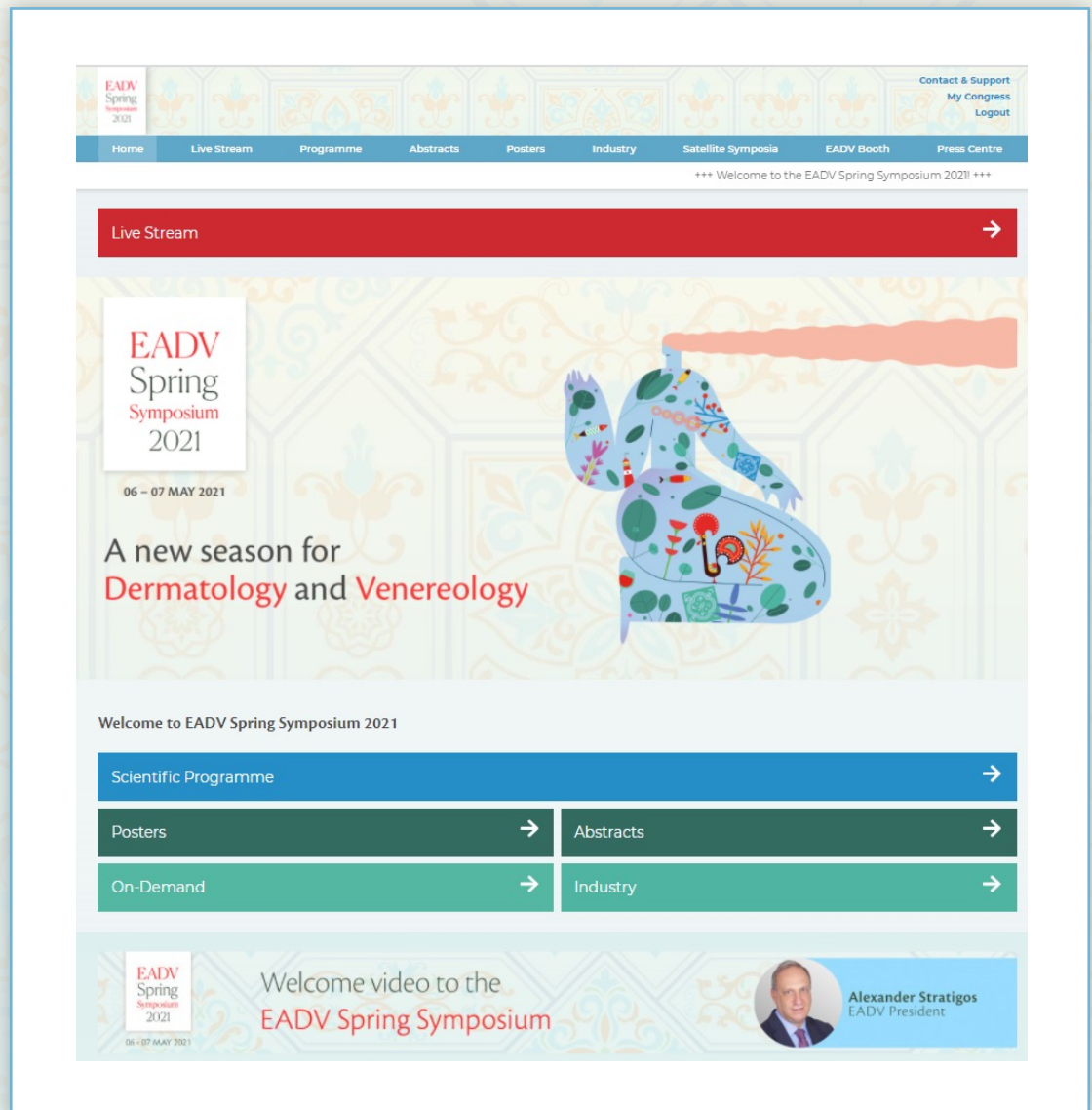

On the Spring Symposium home page you can easily access all areas of the Symposium by using the top menu bar.

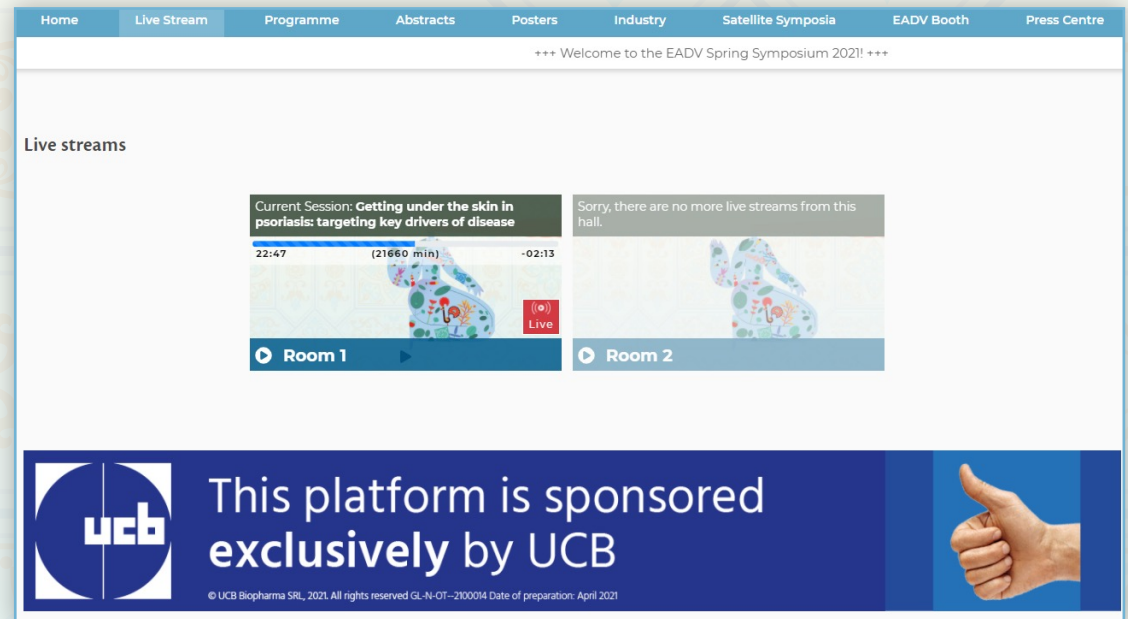

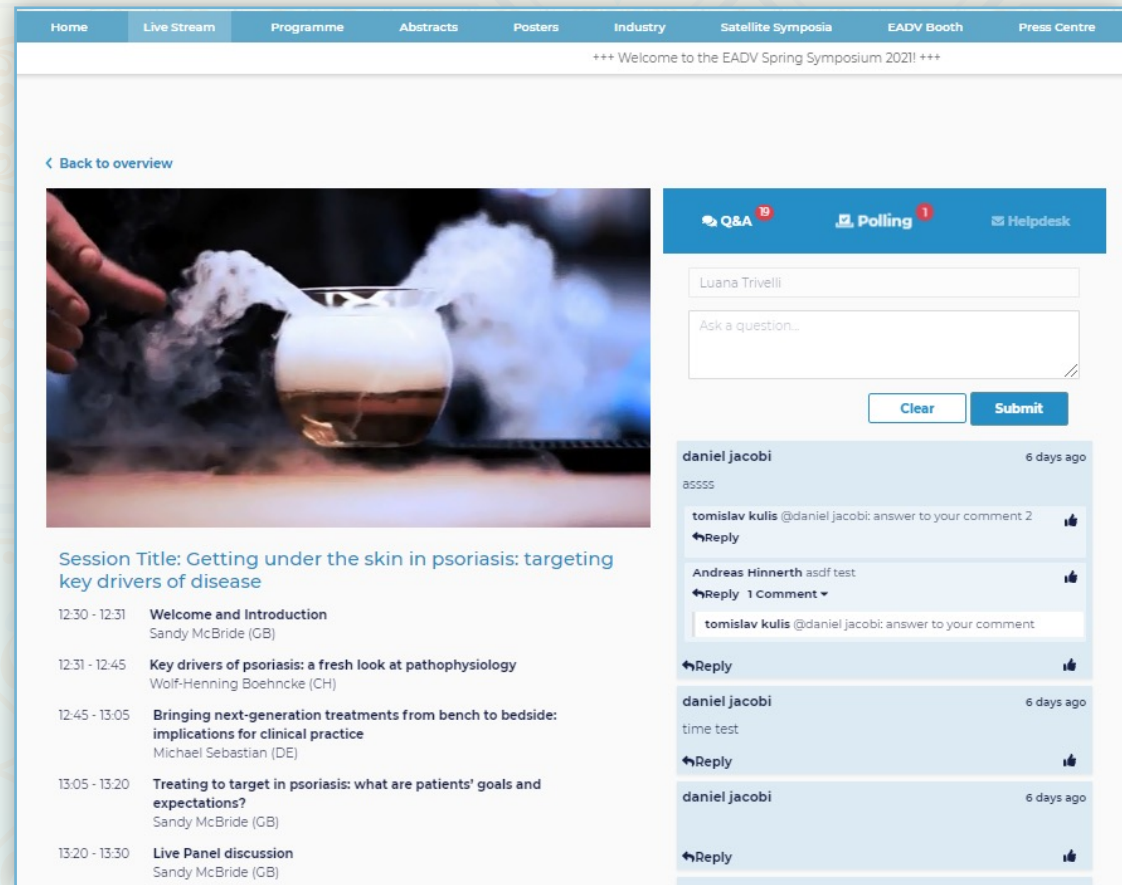
Click on the “**Live Sessions**” banner, or the button in the top menu bar to see all live sessions.

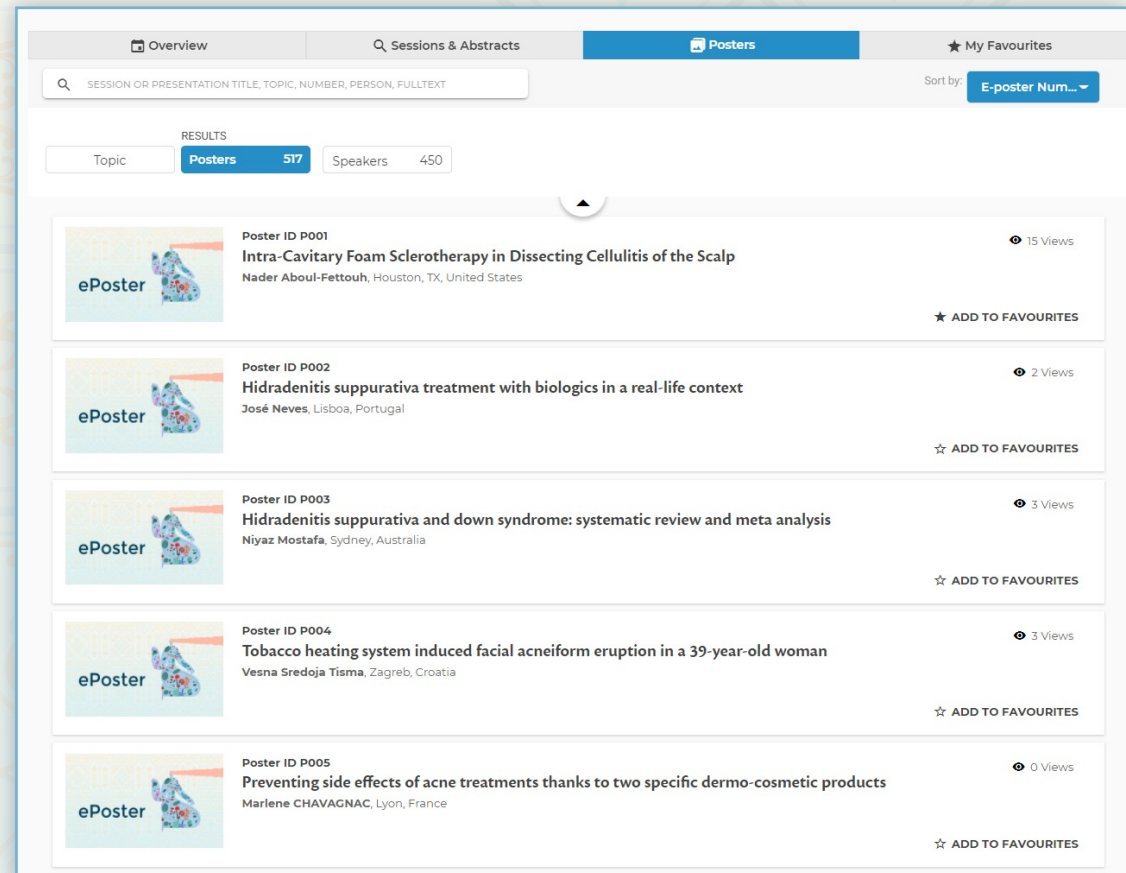

The Introduction states that during pregnancy, several physiological, hormonal, immunological, metabolic and vascular changes occur, and the skin is one of the first organs that may be affected. The Materials and methods section describes a case of a sudden whitish macule eruption on the belly that occurred in the 30 weeks of pregnancy. The Results section describes a 33-year-old female patient with no particular history, on the 36 weeks of pregnancy presented 6 weeks ago a white macule with irregular borders of the belly with a downward extension, the patient didn't complain about itch neither pain, there was no sclerosis, or scales on the physical examination. The Discussion section states that pregnancy dermatosis are classified into: physiological skin changes, pre-existing dermatoses affected by pregnancy, and specific dermatoses of pregnancy. The Conclusion states that it is therefore important to differentiate this physiological pigmentation to other skin conditions such as: vitiligo, pityriasis alba, postinflammatory hypopigmentation, Bier's spot, pityriasis versicolor and nevus anemicus/hypochromicus to avoid unnecessary treatment and to reassure pregnant women about the benignity of this condition.
